

THREE GET BADGES

At Second-Class Test of Montreal Ski Club

The Second Class Test of the Montreal Ski Club, which was held at Shawbridge, resulted in three members receiving the badge for having fulfilled the conditions. They were F. MacKinnon, R. MacKinnon and K. Hague, the latter being a member of the affiliated McGill Ski Club. Nine skiers in all completed the first part of the test, which included a cross country run of four miles taking in an 800 foot climb, but the snow conditions were bad for the swings, which comprise the second part of the test, preventing all with the exception of three named above from qualifying.

The order in which the runners finished part "A" and their times is as follows: F. MacKinnon, 34.50; K. H. Hague, McGill, 36.40; R. MacKinnon, and Lee Strathy, McGill (tied), 38.55; Reusch, St. Gallen, Switzerland, Ski Club, 39.25; Kruch, Zurich, Switzerland, Ski Club, 40.35; Maxwell, 44.40; W. Denman, 46.05; R. A. Brodie, 46.20; W. L. Paul, 46.30.

On Saturday afternoon the Intermediate Jumping competition will be held at the Cote des Neiges jumps, when all the members of the Montreal Ski Club, who have not won a senior event, will be eligible to compete. Owing to the condition of the snow the events will be held over the Green Jumps. On February 15 a long tour will be held from the rendezvous of the club at Shawbridge, weather permitting. Luncheon will be taken in a rucksack, and all the members who intend going along are advised to leave Saturday afternoon as the

tour will start before the arrival of the morning train February 15.

Preparations are being made for the holding of the championship jumping competitions of the club a week from Saturday, and entries have already been received from Berlin Mills, Ottawa, and several outside cities, assuring a good list of competitors.
