

DARTMOUTH WON RELAY

Defeated McGill Team in Shawbridge Contest

Shawbridge, February 22 — The members of the Montreal Ski Club held an outing here this afternoon that was perhaps the most successful since its inception. Following the jumping competition at Montreal on Saturday, a special car was attached to the 11.15 train, bringing out about thirty skiers from Dartmouth College, McGill, Ottawa, Berlin Mills and Montreal, while another detachment came out this morning. Shortly after their arrival the cross country race was held. The course was over a distance of about ten miles, for which good time was made.

The race was won by Oscar Anderson, Montreal Ski Club, time 1.24.08; second, F. McKinnon, time 1.24.29; third, Alec Olsen, time 1.29.37. The first three were members of the Montreal Ski Club. Fourteen entries in all were made. The race was a strenuous one and as the Montreal Club are sending a team to Ottawa next week they may then have to exert their best powers to hold their honors with the club of that place.

In the afternoon the first relay race on skis ever held in Canada followed between Dartmouth College, of Hanover, N.H., and McGill. Starting at the top of a moderate incline, two representatives of the clubs started on a course of two miles. The first lap was made in 17 minutes and a few seconds. The other laps, however, were done in equivalent or better time and Dartmouth won out in 1.06.45. The finish was exciting in the extreme, as the two last runners came into view practically side by side. First the McGill man fell at a sharp turn, which the Dartmouth man negotiated. He fell shortly after and it looked all McGill. However, their man struck a rut and swerved over the track and Dartmouth shot ahead, and within fifty yards of the finish took a lead which he maintained to the end.
